Questions and Answers

Q: I've looked at the announcements for the grants for Farmers' Markets and have seen only a deadline of June 17, 2011 which already passed. However, the announcement was sent on July 8, 2011.

Could you please clarify?

A: The evaluation form is for the evaluator; we included the evaluator form, so that the grantee has an idea of the different areas he/she will be evaluated by the evaluator. To respond to your second question, I believe you're accessing the incorrect funding announcement. Q: There are only four attachments and no general guidelines or lists of objectives. Where can I find those?

A: The goal of this initiative is to promote worksite wellness among Consortium member organizations to increase the number of worksite wellness programs that implement nutrition related policies and physical activity. Furthermore, the expected outcome of this initiative is to increase by 20% the availability of healthier foods from farmer's markets, located in public service venues (i.e. government facilities).
