Topics include nutrition, agriculture, psoriasis, grant writing, diabetes, strategic planning, and community needs assessments. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mirelys Ramos will provide an updated report on the speakers and discussion topics available to date.
Breast Cancer Awareness Month	<p>Rooney Brodie spoke regarding the possibility of working together to focus committee efforts on an educational event surrounding Breast Cancer Awareness.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Katiana Pierre-Diaz, from the YWCA Greater Miami-Dade, suggested the possibility of working on a kick-off event prior to the race to the cure event. - Janisse Schoepp asked if there was need of any educational materials, or of educational presentations. - The YWCA has materials, but is looking for more venues to disseminate information and raise awareness. - Based on a Cancer report sent by the Health Foundation of South Florida, Janisse Schoepp suggested identifying the hot spots and making sure we can distribute educational materials in those areas. 	
Elder Issues: Preventive Services Under Medicare	The Elder Issues Committee is working on a campaign to inform the elderly population about preventative services available to them through Medicare.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rooney Brodie brought it to the committee's attention to see if there was an interest in collaborating and forming a small sub-group. - Janisse Schoepp mentioned reaching out to Hugo Huapaya, who works with Medicare, to see if he had any educational materials that could be shared with the Elder Issues Committee. 	
<p>WIC NEMS Results Presentation</p>	<p>Carla Munoz, Laura Fries, and Lindsey Phipps, from MDCHD-WIC and Nutrition, presented on the Nutrition Environments Measures Survey (NEMS).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 32 stores were surveyed in six Miami zip codes. - The availability of 12 items was measured. Food items were assessed for freshness, appearance, and cleanliness. - The maximum score for stores was 64. The average for a WIC score was 60.4, and the average for a non-WIC store was 42.75. - This research is the first of its kind in Miami-Dade County/ South Florida. <p>Karen Hamilton, from the South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC), will be conducting a NEMS survey within 13 zip codes as part of CPPW efforts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In addition, SFRPC will be working with FIU's Neighborhood HELP program to collect attitudinal surveys from both vendors and consumers. - Karen Weller, MDCHD, requested for both groups to collaborate to avoid duplication.

<p>CPPW Updates</p>	<p>Karen Weller, MDCHD, provided a CPPW update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Food Trust will be commencing their food desert assessment by the end of September, 2011. - There is a solution underway to get the Farmers' Market grantees onboard. - The media campaign has various Make Healthy Happen commercials airing. - A showcase will be held on September 30th, 2011 to highlight all the work that CPPW has been doing in the community. - Some policy briefs concerning child care centers will be presented to legislature in hope of establishing policies that deal with menu changes and physical activity guidelines. 	
<p>Updates</p>	<p>Tobacco Update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A Youth Tobacco Prevention event will be occurring on November 18th, 2011 in Hialeah, with the Parks and Recreation Department. <p>Access to Healthy Foods Workgroup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Is working to create a friendlier environment for non-profit organizations to run farmers' markets. - Partnering with the City of Miami Planning and Zoning departments to develop language for the permitting process and a clear definition of a farmers' market.
