Welcome and Introductions	The Consortium for a Healthier Miami-Dade Health Promotion and Disease Prevention Committee meeting was brought to order by Leyanee Perez at 2:00 PM.		
Approval of Minutes	There was a motion to approve the December 2024 Health Promotion and Disease Prevention meeting minutes by Mayra Garcia and the motion was seconded by Natouchka Murray.		
Executive Board Update	• Consortium Elections: Consortium nominations have started this month. Elections are upcoming for the next 2-year leadership term (2025-2026).		
Member Spotlight	• This month's member spotlight was for Kathleen Sarmiento from Alliance for Aging, an agency that serves people aged 60 and older and disabled adults living in Miami-Dade and Monroe counties who are seeking a program to pay for their long-term care, including assisted living facilities and home health aides. People can contact them through their call center to be assessed and referred to a department that does intake and screening for programs that help pay for this long-term care, such as Medicaid long-term managed care program, Community Care for the Elderly, or the Alzheimer's Disease Initiative. The Alliance is responsible for placing these people on the state-wide waiting list based on danger of premature nursing home placement. The Alliance also gives out \$70 million every six years to companies and organizations that take care of older people. Kathleen manages the alliance's SHINE program, which is a federal grant for trained volunteer counselors to provide information about Medicare, either over the phone or in-person. The program has applications to help pay for Medicare, such as Low Income Subsidy for Part D and the Medicare Savings Program. They also do presentations throughout the week about Medicare, the Alliance for Aging, fraud prevention, and long-term care.

Performance Measures in Need of Improvement	• The Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade and the Consortium for a Healthier Miami-Dade worked to host the 5 th annual Bounty of Health community health fair on Friday, December 13, 2024 at the West Perrine Health Center, featuring free health screenings, food distribution, a mobile food market, health education resources, community activities, and free giveaways.
