Media Update Healthy Happens Here Map/Website	Dr. Valerie Turner gave an overview of the Healthy Happens Here/PICH interactive map, which depicts participating locations to access healthy food and physical activity throughout the county. Restaurants, parks, farmer markets, West Kendall Baptist Hospital, and the Liberty City Health and Wellness Center. Alina Soto proposed the idea of creating a palm card, which lists the location of parks, healthy hubs and restaurants. Dr. Turner advised that DOH will focus on redesigning the website and mobile access in year 3 of PICH. Karen Hamilton suggested engagement strategies should include access to users with technology. Collaborating with the Greater Miami Convention and Visitors Bureau to include the Healthy Happens Here initiative sites would be an effective opportunity to leverage existing resources and expand the Consortium's reach, by creating a mobile app to showcase the Consortium and the different committees and their initiatives.
