#### Alliance for a Healthier Generation – Julia Onnie-hay:

- Will be presenting framework to 15-20 out of school time sites
- Representing the Alliance's mission of reducing childhood obesity and chronic diseases in youth through three prong strategy: Working with 1) Schools, 2) Out of school time sites that serve youth and 3) Insurance industry
- Recruiting 15-20 after school and summertime sites in adopting this framework; making environmental changes at the sites that increase access to healthy foods and opportunities for physical activity
- Services will be free to the sites and will provide small mini-grants (\$1000-\$1500) to the sites to help implement the framework
- Will be identifying the sites within the next month

- Recruiting 12-15 people to help share the wellness program throughout the community
