MAPP 2013 (Mobilizing for Action Through Partnership \& Prioritization) -2018 Miami Dade County Community Health Goals will be the focus for Children Issues Committee. Priorities being the first three listed. MAPP priority rankings are: 1) Access to Care 2) Chronic Disease and Prevention 3) Health Care Disparities. Updated 2010~2013 Work Plan will be created from this.

## Anthony (Author of Henry Gets Moving)

- Work Plan Strategy~Explore Student Membership: reaching out to the different universities along with Alfie Leon (FIU). Tying in their collaboration with the American college of sports medicine with Henry (Henry Gets Moving) and exercise medicine on campus groups. Engage schools in Miami~ Dade County, Broward County, and Palm Beach County to start their exercise medicine on campus group. Especially in Miami Dade where they can then be part of the Consortium and engage in hands~on activities.
- Anthony is working on a Henry Gets Moving toolkit action plan curriculum with professors across the world. Wants to create this as an action plan for Consortium members.
$>$ Next Step: Anthony will sit down with Dr. Natale and other interested Children Issues members reaching out to the universities/schools talking to them about the Consortium and Henry Gets Moving and mentioning the exercise medicine on campus. Having these groups on campus and getting the Consortium involved. Saying to the universities/schools these are the long term opportunities they have to help the community. One suggested university is the University of Miami.

- Work Plan Strategy~ Invite Other Key Health Organizations involved with child health to join the committee. Dr. Natale invited Pam Hollingsworth (attended the Nemours meeting) to the CI committee meeting.
