Executive Board Update	KH provide an update for the Executive Board meeting: the Community Action Plans (CAP) have been submitted to the CDC and will be returned with changes that must be made. Higher policy impact has been recommended. Budget to be approved by CDC has to be changed to reflect yearly Expenses. These requirements from CDC have to be met before bids are requested. The Executive board needs to give guidance on creating initiatives that have a larger reach. The CDC expects that at least 75% of the population health in Miami-Dade be impacted through the PICH. Committee members should be involved in the development of the initiatives, therefore criteria development should be conducted within the committees.
