Updates from the Chair	• Nancy Hernandez Maidique provided executive board updates. She discussed the CDC visit in regards to the Partnership to Improve Community Health (PICH) grant and how they strongly suggest collaboration among the committees of the Consortium. Elder Issue committee has the support of the Mayor's office for the smoke free senior residential. She also provided an overview of all the initiatives of the PICH grant and the focus areas (smoke free environments, nutrition, physical activity, clinical linkage, and communication). In closing she discussed the success of the local decision maker meetings and activities of the smoke free environment initiatives (Public Housing and Senior Residential).
