<p>Presentation on commuters walking/biking data</p>	<p>David Henderson from Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization did a presentation on commuters walking/biking data.</p> <p><u>Highlights of the presentation:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The data that was discussed during the presentation is from the American Community Survey. -The data indicates an increase in the number of people who bike to work in Miami-Dade County. - The upward trend is most seen in the City of Miami and Miami Beach. -The price of the gas, City Bike program, population density and the infrastructure are some of the factors that might contributed to the upward trend. -A tremendous gender gap was observed in the commuters biking data. -A equal distribution is observed in regards to the commuters biking data when factors like race and ethnicity was taken in account. -A slight increase in commuters walking to work was observed. -In conclusion the upward trend of the commuters walking/ biking to work can be sustained through expansion of facilities and programs.
