| New Business | FDOH Miami-Dade held a Florida Healthy Baby Infant Mortality community Meeting on June 17, 2016. During the event, there were four breakout sessions: disease and chronic conditions, nutrition, maternal and child healthcare, and modifiable health risks. The breakout sessions played a vital role to the event as this is where the community and healthcare professions were able to come up with solutions to help reduce Miami-Dade County's health risks. With the information from the breakout sessions, DOH Miami-Dade was able to create an action plan. Activity three on the action plan focuses on increasing breastfeeding initiation and duration rate in Miami-Dade. The taskforce discussed action items, person responsible, deliverables, and key partners. The following are key action items: 1. Access to breastfeeding education and information 2. Breastfeeding resources/ support 3. Social marketing 4. Support in the workplace 5. Support in early care and education 6. Maternal care practices.
