


Common Stressors




34% felt very or moderately worried about not being able to make the minimum payments on their credit cards




38.4% felt very or moderately worried about not being able to pay rent, mortgage, or other housing costs




24.5% felt very or moderately worried about losing their job in the next six months






Where Do You Go For Health Care, Mental Health Care, or Dental Services?




Approximately 25.1% of people spend leisure time outside of their house 1-2 times a week







Personal Outlook




How Would You Rate the Quality of Life in Your Neighborhood?
