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Breast Exam & Breastfeeding Assessment

AFTER BABY ARRIVES

Hospital Visit & Infant Feeding Assessment

Within 48 hours of discharge and during postpartum visits, our OB Team will connect with you to tend to your and baby's breastfeeding needs; our Pediatrics Team will do the same during your child's pediatric visits, up to 3 years of age and as desired.

Upcoming Appointments

- JTCHS Pediatrics: Securing your baby's first visit with our Pediatrician 3-5 days after delivery.

- JTCHS OB/GYN: Following-up with your postpartum checkup 4-6 weeks after delivery.

Your Right to Breastfeed

- Florida Statutes protects your right to breastfeed in public or, if you prefer a private area, in a designated room (e.g. exam room).
- Federal Law requires a) your health insurance to cover costs of breastfeeding support services and in-network breast pump as preventive health service and essential health benefit, and b) your employer to give reasonable break time so that you may express milk in a private area.
- JTCHS has policies in place to encourage the initiation, duration, and exclusivity of breastfeeding, while also ensuring a positive breastfeeding experience for you and baby!
