Welcome and Introductions	The Consortium for a Healthier Miami-Dade Health Promotion and Disease Prevention Committee meeting was brought to order by Leyanee Perez at 2:00pm.	
Approval of Minutes	There was a motion to approve the March 2022 Health Promotion and Disease Prevention minutes by Teri Arvesu; the motion was seconded by Amber Graham.	
Executive Board Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The Executive Board continues to plan the Consortium's Mental Health Summit. The event will take place on Friday, September 16th, 2022. Kevin Andrews, Executive Vice President of Integrated Outpatient Clinical Operations of Banyan Health Systems, has been selected as keynote speaker to present on the topic of Mental Health and Stigma. ▪ The Board continues discussing the community's role with COVID-19. Last month we were at a 3% positivity rate, last week we were at a 13% of positivity. Positivity rate today is at 17%. So as the numbers continue to rise, we need to be more careful. It is important to have our mask on and that we get vaccinated. ▪ The Board also had a discussion on the CDC COVID-19 in Health Equity Grant, which is built around the five social determinants of health. Many organizations are doing similar work throughout entire Miami-Dade County.

This is for better health since due to COVID-19 a good amount of the population took a long time to get vaccinated or did not get vaccinated because they do not have access to the information. Whether they cannot read or comprehend the information. The organization is hoping to help them have a better quality of life through being able to read a prescription or their doctor's instructions to help support the healthcare system and reduce health inequities.
