Taskforce Update	Schottenloher. The Healthy Baby Taskforce is a sub-committee of the Children Issues committee. The	
	Taskforce last met in August in which they continue the discussion on the importance of doulas,	
	climate crisis, and proper compensation for this work in this arena being done in maternal child health.	
	The work with the Human Rights Watch (HRH) was also shared on this matter and that they are	
	working on a report with Taskforce partners to launch. The Healthy Baby, Healthy Corner Store	
	initiative that the Taskforce has been working on has completed all translations which include English,	
	Spanish, and Creole translation for the Palm Card and Business Wallet Card designs. These designs are	
	now in the approval process with DOH Communications. The Baby Safe Sleep Community Survey is	
	also still active and to be shared with the community. Also, during the HealthConnect One's

CI QR Code Resource Flyer	The Children Issues QR Code Resource Flyer has undergone revisions, incorporating recommended changes discussed in the previous meeting. These revisions encompass areas such as mental health awareness and an expanded focus on virus prevention, covering cold, flu, and COVID-19. The updated flyer will be up for approval in the upcoming weeks. Further details will be shared in the next meeting.	
Elder Issues Collaboration Discussion	As previously discussed, Elder Issues Committee is collaborating with the Children Issues Committee to host an inter-generational community walk. The Elder Issues Committee has identified 16 zip codes of interest to host the walk. The Elder Issues Committee conducted a site visit to Deerwood Bonita Lakes Park, which is a park that is within the identified zip codes and already has an older adult program. Elder Issues have been working with Children Issues leadership, Miami-Dade Parks, AARP, and NAMI Miami-Dade. The walk is tentatively scheduled to be on Saturday, January 13, 2024, but specific roles and responsibilities for planning the event have not yet been solidified and further updates will be shared during the Friday, October 20, 2023 meeting.	
Performance Measures in Need of Improvement (Work Plan Review)	 The committee will discuss the following work plan activities during the next meeting in October. The following indicators are remaining activities that the committee prioritized earlier this year and still need to be completed. These will be further brainstormed next month. By September 30, 2024, the Children Issues Committee will develop a strategy to increase the use of Telehealth and its services. By September 30, 2024, will increase the use of the Healthy Kids and Healthy Future Curriculum. By September 30, 2024, the Children Issues Committee will increase from 0 to 2 new Walking School Bus sites. By September 30, 2024, the Children Issues Committee will increase education to childcare providers about food allergies. By September 30, 2024, the Children Issues Committee will fund a children's book related to 	
	Alzheimer's Disease and related dementias.
